



Wernddu Golf Club - Rules of Membership

1. The club shall be called Wernddu Golf Club.
2. The management of the club shall be the Watkins family of Wernddu farm, Abergavenny. Their decision on any matter concerning any aspect of the club, ground, administration or Membership is final.
3. The management will run the club in accordance with the rules of golf as defined by the royal and ancient of St. Andrews, and in particular the normal standards of etiquette in respect of conduct and dress must be adhered to.
4. There will be 6 types of Membership
 - a. Adult (31+)
 - b. Young Adult (25 – 30)
 - c. Youth (18 – 24)
 - d. Junior (17 and Under)
 - e. County (25 Miles +)
 - f. Joint (Couple)
5. New applicants for membership should be known to an existing member and should be proposed by him/her or approved by a member of staff.
6. On receipt of a completed application form and fee the management will consider the application. In the event that the application is rejected the fee will be refunded. No reason for the rejection need be given.
7. If membership is accepted the new member will be issued with a membership card and where applicable a handicap certificate. Existing handicap certificates from previous or present clubs will be accepted.
8. All members will be eligible to enter the handicap system and applicable club competitions. Members will not be required to pay “Green Fees” on the course or on the Pitch 'n' Put facility. Tee off times should be reserved wherever possible.
9. One guest per member may play at £10.00
10. Members will be expected to observe the rules of golf, etiquette and dress at all times. Members must also ensure that club property is respected at all times.
11. This membership is non-transferable.
